

Participant charter SynthFest France 2027

You have expressed your desire to contribute to SynthFest 2027: thank you! To ensure that everything runs as smoothly as possible, it is necessary for participants and the SynthFest France Association to make mutual commitments.

This charter sets out these mutual commitments:

- The SynthFest France association provides you with a designated space to set up your equipment and connect it to the power supply provided. The Association undertakes to respect the dimensions specified in advance.
- Equipment brought by participants must be set up, connected, and dismantled by themselves. At the request of exhibitors, members of the SynthFest France association or its authorized volunteers may assist with setup or dismantling. However, in the event of damage to equipment caused by members of the association or its authorized volunteers, no compensation may be claimed.

The equipment on display is **your responsibility and under your supervision**. SynthFest France cannot be held responsible for any damage or theft of your equipment, nor for any damage caused to third parties by your equipment. Exhibitors are required to ensure that their equipment **complies with current standards**. By accepting this charter, participants acknowledge that they have valid civil liability insurance.

- Image rights: by accepting this charter, the Participant grants SynthFest France, its representatives, and any person acting with their permission, photographer, or director (including any entity publishing or distributing the images, sounds, or finished product) irrevocable permission to photograph, record, or film them during the SynthFest France 2027 event and to use the images collected in any form whatsoever.
- Being an exhibitor at Synthfest inherently requires mutual respect among exhibitors, particularly in terms of limiting noise pollution, respecting assigned spaces, and ensuring visibility for all. Any behavior that disrupts harmonious relations among exhibitors will be addressed by the organizers, who are committed to ensuring respect for everyone, regardless of seniority, brand prominence, or status. Behavior that runs counter to the spirit of sharing and goodwill promoted by the association may lead the organizers to close a booth.

Specific information for exhibitors contributing to the organizational costs:

- The financial contribution requested must be paid before the event. This is a condition of your access to the space reserved for you. An invoice will be sent to the billing address provided on the registration form. The payment of this invoice constitutes an acceptance of our general terms and conditions of sale, which will be attached to this invoice.
- If you have been allocated a time slot for a demonstration, we ask that you adhere to the schedule and duration. Any delay for which the exhibitor is solely responsible may result in the cancellation or reallocation of the slot allocated to you, without compensation.
- Exhibitors are permitted to sell new equipment on site.
- We ask that you be present for the entire duration of the event, out of consideration for Sunday visitors who would be disappointed to see the stands deserted too early.
